Pro Bono Partnership of Atlanta



The Pro Bono Partnership of Atlanta (PBPA) seeks to provide lawyers to teach workshops and provide legal services without charge to non-profit organizations operating or planning to operate in the North Georgia area including metropolitan Atlanta. The needed legal services include a wide variety of tasks, such as assistance in protecting intellectual property, corporate and employment matters, and contracts.

Beginning in April, the Section will forward the Pro Bono Partnership's monthly email list of needs for legal assistance to all members of the section. Members who wish to work on a project, will respond directly to representatives of PBPA.
